

Public Housing notice. (This does not apply to Section 8 Rental Assistance)

Based on HUD regulations set forth regarding late rent during a nationally declared emergency. You will be given a **30-day notice for non-payment of rent**, which should allow you time to apply for help with paying your rent through one of the programs identified below.

The website listed below gives information regarding who you may contact to apply for assistance with unpaid rent. There are two different programs to assist with rent payments in Arkansas. The Arkansas Rent Relief program, and the Emergency Solutions Grant program.
